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Plaintiff, R. Alexander Acosta, Secretary of Labor, United States Department of Labor ("Secretary") alleges as follows:

- 1. The Secretary brings this action to enjoin Defendants Southwest Fuel Management, Inc. dba Brea Car Wash & Detail Center ("Southwest Fuel"); Goldenwest Solutions Group, Inc. ("Goldenwest"); California Payroll Group, Inc. ("California Payroll"); Vahid David Delrahim ("D. Delrahim"); Shannon Delrahim ("S. Delrahim"); and Martin Lizarraga ("Lizarraga") (collectively referred to as "Defendants"), from violating the provisions of Sections 6, 7, 11, and 15 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended ("FLSA"), 29 U.S.C. §§ 206, 207, 211, 215, and to recover wages owed under the FLSA to present and former employees of the Defendants, as listed by name on the attached Exhibit 1 to this Complaint and others whose identities become known through the course of this litigation, together with an equal amount as liquidated damages pursuant to Section 16(c) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 216(c), for the period of time from June 23, 2013 to the present.
- 2. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction of this action under Section 17 of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 217; this Court also has subject matter jurisdiction of this action under 28 U.S.C. § 1331 (federal question) and 28 U.S.C. § 1345 (United States as Plaintiff).
- 3. Venue lies in the United States District Court, Central District of California, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

DEFENDANTS ARE EMPLOYERS UNDER THE FLSA

4. (a) Defendant Southwest Fuel is a California corporation, with its headquarters and address located at 29501 Canwood St., Suite 200, Agoura Hills, California 91301, in Los Angeles County. At all material times, Southwest Fuel on information and belief, has employed workers to operate its car wash/gas station businesses at Brea Car Wash & Detail Center ("Brea Car Wash"), a full service car wash, lube center, gas station, and convenience store located at 1700 East Lambert Road, Brea, California 92821; One Stop Mart, a Union 76 gas station and convenience

store, which is located at 11920 E. Foothill Blvd., Rancho Cucamonga, California 91739; and a Union 76 gas station and convenience store, which is located at 1050 SE Plum St., Olympia, Washington 98501.

Defendant Goldenwest is a California corporation, with its

4 5 headquarters and address also located at 29501 Canwood St., Suite 200, Agoura Hills, 6 7 8 9

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California 91301, in Los Angeles County. At material times, Goldenwest has, on information and belief, operated, overseen, managed, directed, set and carried out all administrative functions, and set the enterprise-wide policies and procedures for Southwest Fuel and its employees at the locations above. Defendant Goldenwest has also, at material times, operated, overseen, managed, direct, set and carried out administrative functions, and set the enterprise-wide policies and procedures (including human resources policies and procedures) for full-service car wash and detail centers owned and operated by Defendant D. Delrahim, including but not limited to: • Brea Car Wash, described above;

- Coast Hand Car Wash & Detail Center, located at 5677 E. 7th St., Long Beach, CA 90804;
- Alicia Auto Spa, located at 24795 Alicia Pkwy., Laguna Hills, CA 92653;
- Las Posas Car Wash, located at 100 S. Las Posas Rd., Camarillo, CA 93010;
- Laguna Hills Auto Spa, located at 25172 Cabot Rd., Laguna Hills CA 92653;
- Agoura Hills Car Wash, located at 30245 Canwood St., Agoura Hills, CA 91301;
- Lavaggio, located at 30205 Canwood St., Agoura Hills, CA 91301;
- Redlands Car Wash and Detail Center, located at 27300 W Lugonia Ave., Redlands, CA 92374;
- Placentia Car Wash, located at 600 N Rose Dr, Placentia, CA 92870;
- Newport Coast Car Wash, located at 4200 Birch St., Newport Beach, CA 92660; and
- Steve's Detailing, located at 4200 Birch St., Newport Beach, CA 92660.

Defendant California Payroll is a California corporation, with its

1 headquarters and address also located at 29501 Canwood St., Suite 200, Agoura Hills, 2 3 California 91301, in Los Angeles County. At material times, California Payroll has, on information and belief, served as the enterprise-wide, centralized payroll administrator 4 5 and manager for Southwest Fuel and its employees at the locations above and for Goldenwest and its employees at the locations identified in paragraph (b). Employees 6 7 receive paychecks from California Payroll directly, regardless of which location they 8 work at. California Payroll manages payroll and performs administrative payroll

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- 5. Defendant D. Delrahim, owner and President of Southwest Fuel, Goldenwest, and California Payroll, at all material times, acted directly or indirectly in the interest of all corporate Defendants in relation to their employees as managing agent, and is an employer under Section 3(d) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 203(d). Defendant D. Delrahim makes enterprise-wide decisions, directs and oversees, and has the authority to direct and oversee, the operations, pay rates and raises, practices, payroll, terms of employment, and the supervisors and managers of Southwest Fuel and at all of his car wash and detail locations, including those locations listed in Paragraph 4(b) above.
- 6. Defendant S. Delrahim at material times acted directly or indirectly in the interest of all corporate Defendants in relation to their employees as a managing agent, and is an employer under Section 3(d) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 203(d). Defendant S. Delrahim makes or has made enterprise-wide decisions, has directed and overseen, and had or has the authority to direct and oversee, the human resources operations, including pay rates and raises, practices, payroll hiring and firing, discipline, assignments of employees, terms of employment, schedules, and the supervisors and managers at Southwest Fuel and at Defendant D. Delrahim's car wash and detail operations, including at the locations listed in Paragraph 4(b) above.
- 7. At material times, Defendants S. Delrahim and D. Delrahim, through California Payroll, Goldenwest, and a variety of other corporate entities owned and/or

controlled by D. Delrahim, established and retained authority to set or change the terms and conditions of employment for the employees of the above listed businesses including but not limited to pay rates and raises, bonuses and commissions, timekeeping, work conditions and hours, approval of discipline and termination, and all matters relating to employee conduct.

- 8. Defendant Lizarraga, manager at Brea Car Wash, at material times, acted directly or indirectly in the interest of Southwest Fuel in relation to its employees as a managing agent, and is an employer under Section 3(d) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 203(d). Defendant Lizarraga manages, oversees and directs work, and has the authority to hire or fire, manage and oversee and direct work, including the work of other Brea Car Wash managers or supervisors and of other employees at Brea Car Wash.
- 9. (a) On information and belief, Defendant D. Delrahim resides within the jurisdiction of this Court.
- (b) On information and belief, Defendant Lizarraga resides within the jurisdiction of this Court.
- (c) On information and belief, Defendant S. Delrahim resides within the jurisdiction of this Court.
- 10. Defendants, individually and jointly, serving as agents for one another, controlled the material aspects of the employment relationship with their employees including, hiring, firing, setting pay rates, setting work schedules, assigning work, assigning employees to work locations, and preparing and maintaining pay records. Defendants designed and maintained an employment structure involving multiple entities with each single entity serving the interests of and/or acting as an agent for the others.
- 11. All Defendants are employers under Section 3(d) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 203(d).

DEFENDANTS' EMPLOYEES ARE ENTITLED TO THE WAGES AND PROTECTIONS OF THE FLSA

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- 12. Defendants' activities constitute and at all relevant times have constituted related activities performed through unified operation or common control for a common business purpose, and are and at all relevant times have been an "enterprise" as defined in FLSA § 3(r), 29 U.S.C. § 203(r).
- 13. Defendants' employees were or are engaged in commerce and/or in handling or working on goods that had been moved in commerce, as they regularly handle goods that had or have been shipped from places outside of the state of California. Defendants' enterprise has, and at all relevant times has had, an annual gross volume of sales made or business done of no less than \$500,000.00, and said enterprise constitutes, and at all relevant times has constituted, an "enterprise engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce" as defined by FLSA § 3(s), 29 U.S.C. § 203(s). As such, Defendants' employees are covered by the FLSA, including its wage, recordkeeping, and anti-discrimination provisions.

DEFENDANTS VIOLATED THE FLSA

- Defendants have violated and are violating provisions of Sections 6 and 14. 15(a)(2) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. §§ 206 and 215(a)(2), by employing employees engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce, or employed in an enterprise engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce, within the meaning of the FLSA, at wage rates less than the applicable federal minimum wage.
- 15. Defendants have violated and are violating provisions of Sections 7 and 15(a)(2) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. §§ 207 and 215(a)(2), by employing employees engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce, within the meaning of the FLSA, or employed in an enterprise engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce, within the meaning of Section § 3(s) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 203(s), for workweeks longer than 40 hours without compensating said employees for their employment in excess of 40 hours in such workweeks at rates not less than one and one-half times the regular rates at which they were employed.
 - 16. Defendants have violated and are violating the provisions of Sections 11(c)

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and 15(a)(5) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. §211(c) and §215(a)(5), by failing to maintain, keep, and preserve records of employees and of the wages, hours, and other conditions and practices of employment maintained, as prescribed by the regulations promulgated by the Secretary pursuant to the authority granted in the FLSA and published in the Federal Register and known as Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 516.

- During the period since June 23, 2013, Defendants have repeatedly and 17. willfully violated and are violating the above-described provisions of the FLSA. For example:
- (a) Defendants required their employees to report to work and wait, directing and requiring them not to clock in until customers arrived. Likewise, Defendants directed and required their employees to clock out when business slowed down. This resulted in Defendants' employees being required to work numerous off the clock hours, and also resulted in minimum wage and overtime violations.
- (b) Defendants failed to include employees' non-discretionary commission pay into the regular rate, and thereby failed to pay employees one and onehalf times their regular rates at which they were employed for hours worked over forty in a week.
- Defendants failed to keep accurate and complete timekeeping and (c) payroll records.
- 18. As a result of the violations of the monetary provisions of the FLSA, there are unpaid minimum wage and overtime compensation due under the FLSA that are being withheld by the Defendants.
- A judgment permanently enjoining and restraining such violations of the FLSA is specifically authorized by Section 17 of FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 217.
- 20. A judgment enjoining and restraining the continued withholding of unpaid minimum wage and overtime compensation due under the FLSA is specifically authorized by Section 17 of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 217.
 - 21. Judgment awarding unpaid minimum wage and overtime compensation due

under the FLSA, plus an additional amount, as liquidated damages, that is equal to the amount of minimum wage and overtime compensation that accrued under the FLSA, is specifically authorized by Section § 16(c) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 216(c).

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WHEREFORE, cause having been shown, the Secretary prays for a judgment against Defendants, and each of them, as follows:

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- For an order, pursuant to Section 17 of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 217, A. permanently enjoining and restraining Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, successors-in-interest, co-employers, and those persons in active concert or participation with them, from prospectively violating the provisions of Sections 15(a)(2) and 15(a)(5) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. §§ 215(a)(2) and 215(a)(5).
 - В. For an order,
- Pursuant to Section 16(c) of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 216(c), finding (i) the Defendants liable for any unpaid minimum wages and overtime compensation that may be found by the Court to be due under the FLSA plus an additional amount as and for liquidated damages, equal to any minimum wage and overtime compensation found to have accrued under the FLSA, to present and former employees of Defendants including the persons listed by name on the attached Exhibit 1; or
- (ii) In any instances where liquidated damages are not awarded herein, restraining, pursuant to Section 17 of the FLSA, 29 U.S.C. § 217, the Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, successors-in-interest, co-employers, and those persons in active concert or participation with them, from continuing to withhold the payment of any unpaid minimum wage and overtime compensation that may be found by this Court to have accrued under the FLSA to present and former employees of Defendants including the persons listed by name on the attached Exhibit 1, plus prejudgment interest thereon; and,
- Awarding the Secretary the costs of this action and providing such further C. legal and equitable relief as may be deemed appropriate.
