(Felony four year maximum)

On or about and between, January 1, 2020 and October 9, 2020, in the County of San Diego, State of California, Defendant MARIA EROLINA DELGADO, did, under circumstances and conditions likely to produce great bodily harm and death, knowingly and willfully cause and permit the Gloria Caro, an elder and dependent adult, to suffer, and inflicted thereon, unjustifiable physical pain and mental suffering and, having the cause and custody of said victim, willfully caused and permitted her to be placed in a situation in which her health was endangered, and knew and reasonably should have known that said person, Gloria Caro, was an elder and dependent adult.

NOTICE: Upon a felony conviction for the above offense, prison custody time is to be served in state prison pursuant to Penal Code section 1170.

On or about and between, January 1, 2020 and November 5, 2020, in the County of San Diego, State of California, Defendant MARIA EROLINA DELGADO, did, under circumstances other than those likely to produce great bodily harm and death, knowingly and willfully cause and permit the victim, Elizabeth Steele, an elder and dependent adult, to suffer, and inflicted thereon, unjustifiable physical pain and mental suffering and, having the cause and custody of said victim, willfully caused and permitted Elizabeth Steele to be placed in a situation in which her health was endangered, and knew or reasonably should have known that said person, Elizabeth Steele, was an elder and dependent adult.

It is further alleged as to count(s) 1 and 2 that the victim(s) of the above offense(s) was particularly vulnerable, within the meaning of California Rules of Court Rule 4.421(a)(3).
